## Resources to help parents with learning Welsh

- You may have heard about the app **Duolingo**. Apparently it's possible to access it on desktop as well. It's a free language learning app, and there are currently over 500 thousand people learning Welsh with it! It's easy to use and makes language learning fun due to the gamified nature of the lessons.

- **Say Something in Welsh** (<https://www.saysomethingin.com/welsh>) is another popular website and app that many use to learn for free. They also tweet a new Welsh word to learn every day if you're on Twitter. You can find them here - <https://twitter.com/DailyWelshWords?lang=en-gb>
- Another nice Twitter account to know about is **Awr y Dysgwyr** (Welsh learners hour). They host an hour of sharing questions, ideas, and good practice surrounding learning Welsh every Monday from 9-10pm. They have over a thousand followers so it's grown into a really nice community of people coming together to share and help each other every Monday night. - Mudiad Meithrin: **Cynllun Cymraeg i'r Teulu - Welsh for the family Scheme** is a scheme which supports non-Welsh speaking parents/carers who attend the cylchoedd Ti a Fi (Welsh-medium baby and toddler groups). The aim of this scheme is to enable non-Welsh speaking families to learn a bit of Welsh and to use the language in the home. It gives the parents/carers and the children a taste of the Welsh language and demonstrates that Welsh isn't a difficult language to learn!
