- Develop leadership skills



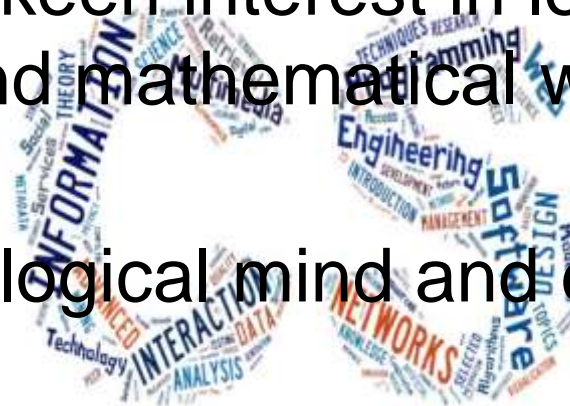
What's involved in the Outdoor Pursuits option?

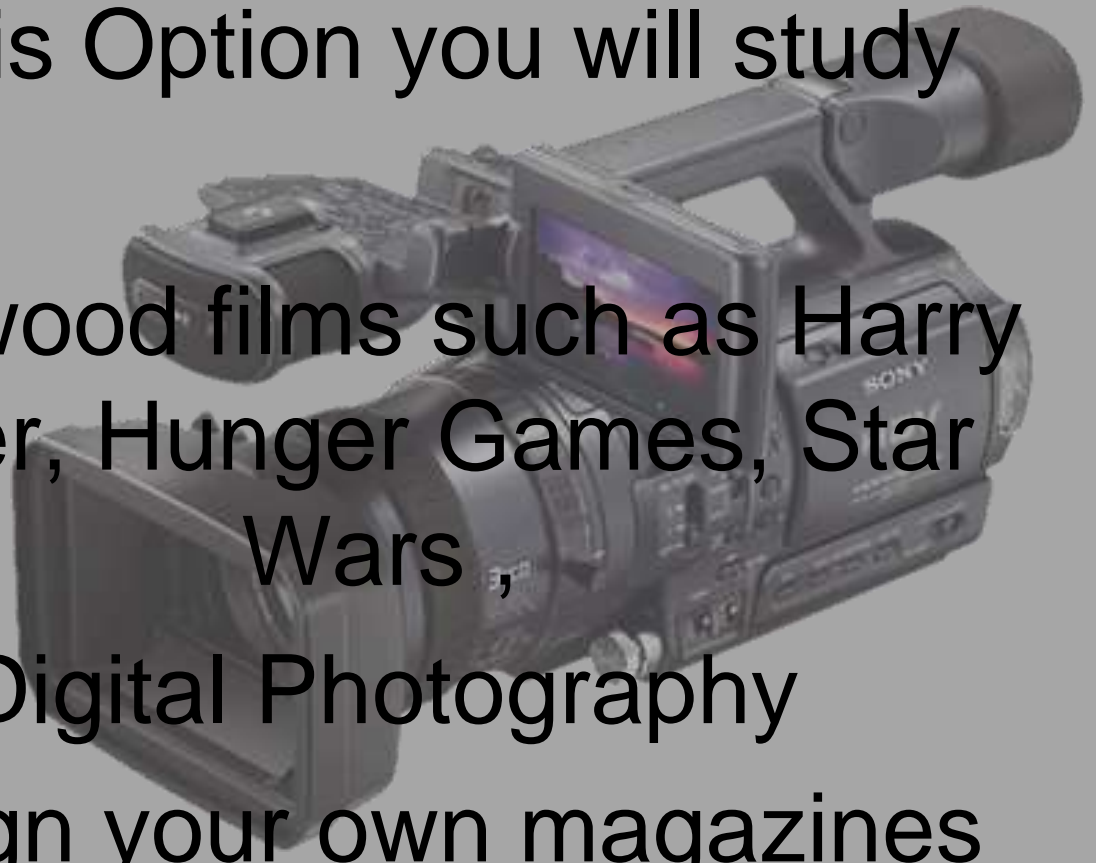
