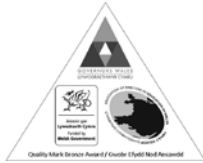

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Dear Parent/Carer,

The next two years form a critically important step in your child's education. At regular intervals during Years 10 and 11, students will undertake controlled assessments and coursework projects that contribute towards their GCSE grades. Furthermore, students will sit examinations in mathematics, science and religious studies during Year 10. Further details of the examination schedule for each subject will be provided by subject teachers during the evening.
