Choosing your options:

- For specialist advice on which type of course is the most suitable for you please speak to the sixth form team at the **Post-16 Open Evening on Thursday 6th February 2020** or email us using the contact details below.
- You should choose four subjects from the option blocks A-E. In the option block where you have not chosen a subject you will need to select 'none' as your option.
- Remember that these are only your provisional choices and there will be several opportunities to change your options before the start of term in September.
- Be aware that the subjects offered in these option lines are a provisional list; the courses will run providing there are a sufficient number of students opting for them.

Double A level subjects:

- Further mathematics is a double A level subject and you must select this in **both** option blocks A and E if you wish to study it.
- Health & social care can be studied as a single A level in option block A. It can also be studied as a single award level 3 diploma in block B or as a double award level 3 diploma by selecting it in both option blocks B and E. If you wish to study 3 qualifications in this subject please seek advice from us.
